

## **EXPO Vehicle Guidelines**

1. Vehicle size should be assessed with your Event Manager for proper clearance into the facility and designated conference space.
2. Vehicle must be cleaned and completely dried before facility access will be granted. Arrangements can be made with your Event Manager to provide water and a location to wash vehicle at the requestor's expense, subject to availability.
3. Protective plastic must be provided in all carpeted areas including the path the vehicle may take before its final display position.
4. If any other motor fluids are detected under the vehicle, please provide an oil absorbent pad to contain the fluid.
5. Please limit fuel to less than ½ of a tank.
  - a. Hydrogen vehicles are limited to ½ tank full as well
6. Please disconnect battery cables.
7. Please give a set of keys to your Event Manager to leave at the Expo Centre Security office, so vehicles can be evacuated if necessary.
8. The Edmonton EXPO Centre/Northlands is not insured for third party losses or damage to the vehicle. The owner takes full responsibility for any damage caused to the vehicle while on Northlands Property.
9. CNG, LNG, LPG (propane), and hydrogen fuel tanks shall have their emergency shut off valve(s) in the closed position.
10. Any vehicles with propane tanks are required to purge the propane tanks prior to entering venue.
11. Movement of vehicles during show hours is prohibited.
12. Fueling or defueling of vehicles on site is prohibited.
13. Motorized equipment and vehicles powered by internal combustion engines are prohibited except in garages, in front of loading docks, in the load-in and load-out of vehicles used for exhibit display purposes, or in case of emergencies.
